It is not necessary to always enter four pieces of work, one slide or one print is sufficient.

The cost of one roll of film is really not prohibitive. All you need to do is take a couple of shots for each subject and then finish off the roll taking photos of subjects you enjoy. This means that all you need to develop is one roll of film. Very cost effective.

It is not necessary to enlarge the prints, as most camera club judges will not deduct points for size.

They look for quality and I know from past experience that ALL our members are capable of providing this quality.

I look forward to seeing work from all members at each level.

It should be noted that if there is only one member entering a competition, only 1st place points are counted. Even though a judge may give a 1st, 2nd & 3rd placing, points are only awarded to the 1st place. This allows the entries that did not get first place to be re-entered in future competitions.
