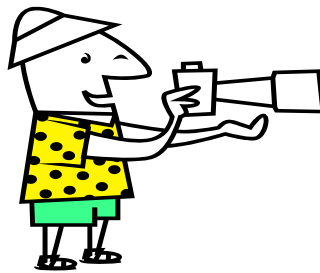

Sorry about this late "March" edition of our newsletter – the days whizzed by before I knew it!

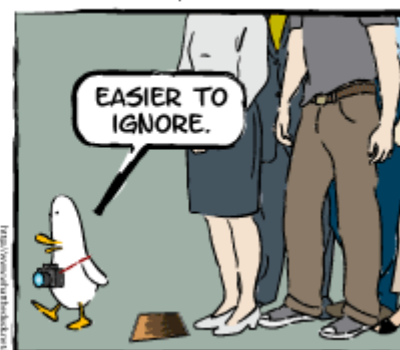
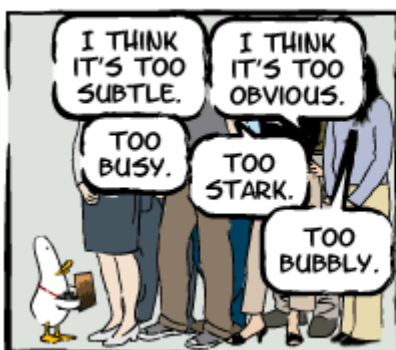

In addition, slides must be spotted in the bottom left corner when viewed correctly. For full details of print and slide labeling refer to information sheet. The competition subject for May is "The Dark Side".
